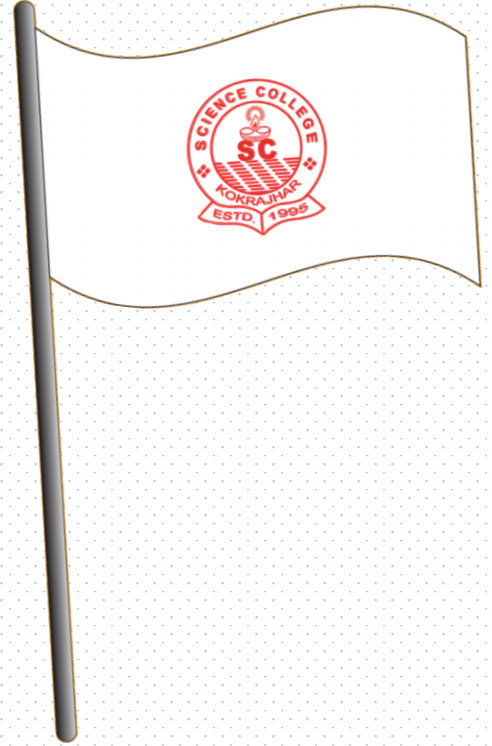

Science College, Kokrajhar was established in the year 1995 and situated at Bhatarmari area of Kokrajhar Town. The College is affiliated under Bodoland University and recognized by University Grants Commission (UGC), New Delhi, Govt of India u/s 2f and 12B of UGC Act 1956. (No.F. 8-381/2005(PPP-I) Visit [www.ugc.ac.in](http://www.ugc.ac.in)) and recognized & provincialized by the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Assam. The College was also accredited by NAAC with CGPA 2.54.

The College was started with the active cooperation and selfless dedication of the people of this locality by 17 Numbers of students in Higher Secondary Science section at the temporary venue of Rastrabhasha Vidyapeeth School, Kokrajhar in morning shift. On 26th July 1996, Mr. Rajendra Kumar Mushahary, the then State Minister WPT & BC, Assam first laid the foundation stone of the College Building. The Degree (B.Sc.) Courses were started in the year 1999.

### Four-Year Undergraduate (FYUG) Programme

(Based on UGC Curriculum and Credit Framework)

The NEP-2020 based Four-Year Undergraduate Programme (FYUP), to be adopted by Bodoland University, is an 8-semester (4-year) programme of 160 credits with multiple exit and entry options at the successful completion of courses assigned at the end of each year.

- Students who opt to exit after completion of the first year and have secured 40 credits will be awarded a UG certificate if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation of the first year.
- Students who opt to exit after completion of the second year and have secured 80 credits will be awarded the UG diploma if, in addition, they complete one vocational course of 4 credits during the summer vacation of the second year.
- Students are allowed to re-enter the degree programme within three years and complete the degree programme within the stipulated maximum period of seven years.
- Students who opt to exit after completion of the third year and have secured 120 credits will be eligible for the UG degree in the Major discipline without Honours.

#### Outline of Courses:

The broad categories of courses and minimum credits required for the 4-year Honours degrees as per the UGC document are as follows:

1. Major (Core):	80 credits
2. Minor:	32 credits
3. Interdisciplinary Course (IDC):	9 credits



4. Ability Enhancement Courses (AEC):	8 credits
5. Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC):	9 credits
6. Value Added Courses (VAC):	8 credits
7. Summer Internship:	2 credits
8. Research Project/Dissertation: (For Honours with Research degree)	12 credits

\* The credits may be altered/changed based on the guidelines of Bodoland University.

The following points may be noted:

- • In lieu of the Research Project, a student may study 3 courses each of 4 credits (i.e. total 12 credits), leading to an Honours degree (without Research).
- • For the 4-year Honours degrees the Major subject/ discipline requires 80 credits and the . Minor subject/ discipline requires 32 credits.
- • For a Double Major, the minimum credit requirements are 48 (3-year degree) and 60 (4- year Honours degree) respectively in a subject/ discipline other than the original Major.
- • In the UGC framework, papers in Major and Minor disciplines are categorized into levels of 100, 200, 300 and 400. Therefore, a course (paper) offered by a Department, say with 4 credits and of level 200, may be taken both as a Major (Core) course by one student and as a Minor course by another student having a different Major discipline, possibly in different semesters.

## **Bachelor of Physiotherapy (BPT)**

Bachelor of Physiotherapy program is offered by Science College, Kokrajhar. The BPT course is designed to meet the Indian standards. The program is taught by qualified faculty and has a balanced exposure of both academic and clinical training. The undergraduate program is for four and a half years. The intake capacity for the B.P.T. course is 30.

**Eligibility:** Higher Secondary in Science (10+2)

**Duration:** 4 and ½ years

## **Certificate and Diploma Courses**

- 6 Months Certificate Course in Computer Hardware & Networking.
- Journalism one year Diploma Course under Gauhati University.



## Higher Secondary Course (10+2) in Science

Science College also offers 2 years H.S. (Science) course. The intake capacity in H. S. (Science) 1st year is 120.

### Subjects offered:

Compulsory : (i) English

(ii) MIL (Any one amongst Assamese, Bodo & Alternative English)

Elective : A students must selected any three or four elective subjects from the following : Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Biology/Computer Science.

N.B: (i) English and MIL each are of 100 marks. 1st, 2nd , 3rd and 4th elective each are also of 100 marks.

(ii) In subjects having practicals, there will be 70 marks for theory and 30 marks for practical in each subject.

Science College, Kokrajhar has open the study centre of the Krishna Kanta Handiqui State Open University (Establishment by an Act of Assam Legislative Assembly ) The University has been recognized and academic programmes approved by the Distance Education Council (DEC), New Delhi Vide Letter No. DEC/Misc/07/5957, dated. 03-10-2007. The University will offer the following programmes :

### **Academic Programmes & Duration**

1. Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA) : 3 (Three) Years/6 Semester
2. Bachelor of Mass Communication (BMC) : 3 (Three) Years
3. Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) : 3 (Three) Years/6 Semester
4. Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) : 3 (Three) Years/6 Semester
5. Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) : 3 (Three) Years/6 Semester
6. Master of Computer Application (MCA) : 3 (Three) Years/6 Semester
7. Master of Arts (MA) (Eng., Ass., Political Sc., Education): 2 (Two) Years./4 Semester

In addition to above, the University will also offer some diploma and Certificate courses in professional and Vocational areas to be notified from time to time.

### **Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA)**

The following learners are eligibility to take admission into the BCA Programme:

- Those who have passed Higher Secondary examination in Science Stream.
- Those who have passed the relevant Bachelor preparatory Programme (BPP) of this University.
- Those who have passed Higher Secondary (10+2) in Arts & Commerce and desire to pursue BCA shall have to successfully complete the Paper IV, V, VI (Electronic & Mathematics) only of BBP course, Paper-I, II, III is not necessary for them. Alternative learners may directly enroll into the BCA.
- Programme provided they take admission simultaneously into the Paper-IV of BBP in the first semester itself and only on successfully completion of the Paper-IV, V, VI of BPP they will be eligible for award of Certificate, Diploma & /or Degree.

### **BMC/BBA/B.Com/BA**

Those who have passed Higher Secondary examination (10+2) in any stream and those who have passed relevant BPP course of KKHSOU are eligible to take admission into any of the Bachelor of Mass Communication (BMC), Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA), Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.) & Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) programmes.

## Simultaneous Admission

A learner can pursue a degree programme and a Diploma or Certificate Course at the same time. Learners pursuing degree programmes under any conventional University can simultaneously take admission in a Degree/ Diploma/Certificate programmes offered by this University. However, a learner shall not be allowed to pursue two Degree programmes of this University simultaneously.

## Master of Computer Application (MCA)

- Any graduate (except Fine Arts) from KKHSOU or any other University recognized by KKHSOU.
- Must have Mathematics at 10+2 Level.
- Those who do not have Mathematics at 10+2 Level, shall have to clear the paper IV, V & VI of stream 3 of Bachelor Preparatory Programme (BBP) within four Semesters. Only after successful completion he/she will be eligible to receive mark sheet/ Certificate of the Semester completed. Separate admission shall be necessary for course.

## Lateral Admission

Any graduate have either PGDCA of this University or any other University recognize by this University or DOEACC 'A' level will be eligible to take admission in 3rd Semester of MCA programme. However, admission of candidates having PGDCA of other Universities will require prior approval of University authority.



## Admission Process

The admission process is completely online. To get admission into Science College, at first log on to [www.sciencecollege.ac.in](http://www.sciencecollege.ac.in) and click on Online Admission Portal.

- Click on New Registration
- Provide your email and contact number. System will automatically fill an secret KEY .
- Proceed further, after successful verification of OTP provide necessary details as name and password and proceed further.
- Dully filled online application form must be submitted on or before the last date as notified by the College.
- For Honors course the student must take counseling before submission of form for admission.

## Documents to be uploaded in online application form

- Mark sheet of the last qualifying examination.
- Pass certificate as well as Character Certificate from the Head of the institution last attended.
- Relevant caste certificate from concern authority in case of candidates applying for admission under reserve category.
- Two copies of the passport size photograph.
- Student passing the qualifying examination earlier to the current year must submit a gap certificate testifying their activities during last year (s).

## Admission Procedure

- The eligibility criteria, reservation of seat and intake capacity of FYUG and M.Sc. admission for the session 2023-24 will remain same as per Govt. rule.
- Selection for admission will be on as per criteria stated below:

▪ Overall marks obtain in previous examination:	30%
▪ Concern subject where opting for Major/Honors:	40%
▪ Departmental (Written/Viva etc.):	30 Marks

At the time of admission, students are required to produce all the original documents from HSLC/10th examination onward for verification. In case there is no candidate satisfying the above criteria the seats will be filled up as per the decision admission committee. The decision of Admission Committee is final in case any dispute/

## Department of Physics

The Department of Physics is one of the prestigious departments of the college. It was established in the year, 1995 along with the College, to offer physics course for the Higher Secondary and B.Sc. Our B.Sc. Physics (honours) course continues to enjoy extremely high demand, So far around 200+ students have completed BSc Honours from our department and a reasonable number of students go for masters in Physics to prepare themselves for research and teaching. Others have excelled in their chosen fields. Some of the institutions where our students have been admitted for higher studies recently are various IITs (through IIT-JAM exam), GU, TU, AU, and BU. Many of them completed their studies and have joined in dignified positions starting from the field of academics, Research to defence, and as well in the private sector. In order to motivate the students, the department organizes regular pieces of training in various aspects of physics, and to enrich their knowledge, the department arranges various workshops, A lot of emphasis is given to 'hands-on' exposure to modern software such as Matlab, Scilab, Python, LaTeX etc through practical and tutorial classes.

The Department of Physics is well known for its untiring efforts and sincere dedication for setting the best standards of the teaching-learning process. 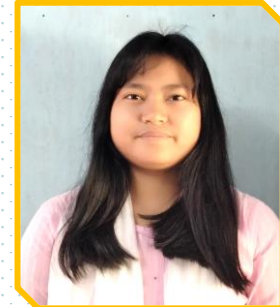

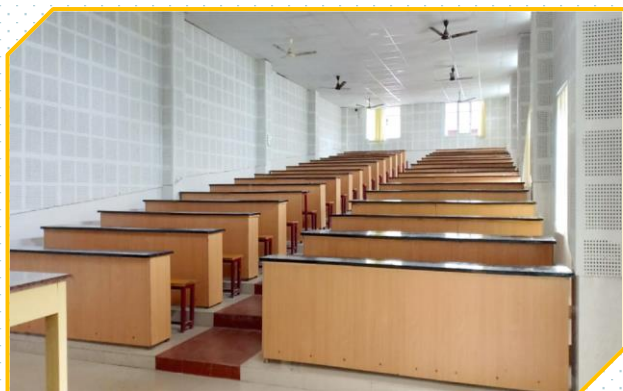
