
### **Birth anniversary of Bodofa “Father of the Bodos”**

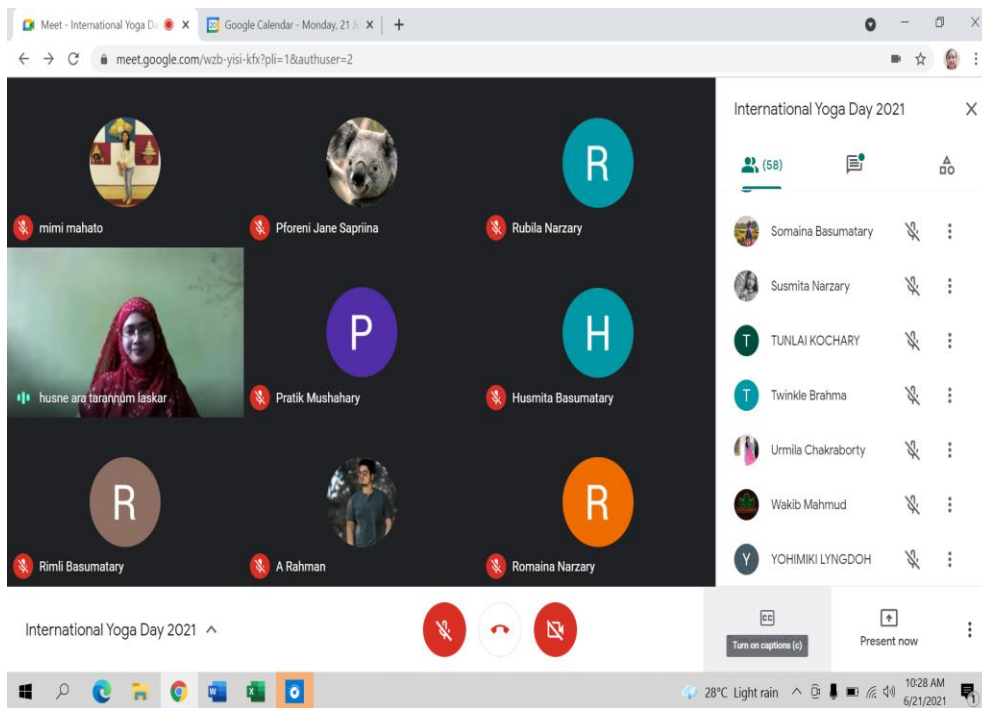
